The MCC has recently started to focus and work with Youth leaders from all its Islamic Centers of Calgary to establish Center-Based Youth Leadership Committees to enable them to contribute their ideas, skills and talents to assist the respective elected committees of each of the following Islamic Centers:

- Al-Hedaya Islamic Center
- South Musalla (ICSC)
- SW Masjid
- NW Musalla (IANWC)

Each Center's Youth Leadership Committee will report to their respective elected local center board and receive functional support from the MCC Youth Director.

There will be at least five focus areas for each:

- Learning
- Leadership development
- Development of work ethics and tools
- Sports
- Networking

An MCC Central Youth Board will also be created and made up from one member from each of those Youth Leadership committees focussing on city-wide youth mission, vision, strategy, benchmarking & collaboration with other local organizations.
